## TENDER INVITATION

### **TRAFFIC SIGNALS: AUDIT & ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION MODEL (PROJECT NO.: 1/08/AA)**

Tenders are hereby invited from suitable companies to develop an electricity consumption model for signals in eThekweni.

#### **The broad scope of the work includes:**

- An audit of all the traffic signals and warning flashers in eThekweni.
- On-site consumption monitoring of 10 representative signals and 2 warning flashers.
- Development of a spreadsheet model to determine the

power consumption per signal and warning flashers.

- Numbering of all intersections and poles.

Tender documents can be obtained from the Cashier located in the basement, City Engineers Building, Old Fort Road, Durban, for a non-refundable deposit of R100. A compulsory briefing session will be held on 2008-03-13, from 14:30 to 15:30, in Room 125, eThekweni Transport Authority (ETA), 30 Old Fort Place. A formal attendance register will be taken, and no proposals will be entertained from firms not having attended the session.

#### **The minimum requirements for the proposals are:**

- A professional transport engineer familiar with the South African Road Traffic Signs Manual
  - A qualified electrician with at least one year's experience in working traffic signals.
- Proposals that do not meet these minimum requirements will NOT be considered for scoring as outlined below.
