

Public notice is hereby given that the eThekweni Municipality is planning to extend the current appointment of re-Ethical Environmental Re-engineering (Pty) Ltd to supply, operate and maintain a specialist Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) at the Mariannhill Landfill Site. There is currently limited recycling and resource recovery being carried out within the eThekweni Municipal Area (EMA) and as the last link on the waste hierarchy i.e. landfills are destined for final disposal and it undoubtedly becomes a waste management problem for increased waste volumes to landfill. Re – Ethical Engineering was engaged through a public advert requesting for quotations to undertake the development of a programme for Resource Recovery in terms of recycling and was found to be most responsive. Re – Ethical had submitted a ‘zero rate’ i.e. no cost to council for the provision, operation and maintenance of all plant required for the recycling. Seeing that is first of its kind for eThekweni and if not for South Africa, it is regarded as a “constantly evolving MRF” whereby it is improved upon on an on-going basis to improve the extraction rates of recyclables from the domestic waste stream. Due to the crash in the commodity prices of recyclables an intervention plan is required which will increase product quality and plant efficiency. It is on this basis that eThekweni Municipality plan to allow re – Ethical Engineering to continue with further enhancements to the MRF and extend the current appointment validity to 31 December 2015. The public hereby is invited to forward any written comments/ representations or setting out objections and the grounds thereof to the undersigned. Representations or objections to the extension of the current appointment validity of re-Ethical Environmental reengineering (Pty) Ltd to supply, operate and maintain a specialist Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) at the Mariannhill Landfill Site shall only be considered valid if: The full names, identity numbers and physical address and contact details of the author is recorded thereon, the interest of the author is recorded fully, the grounds thereof are set out in detail and is lodged with the undersigned at the Tender Box located on the Ground Floor, City Engineers Building, 166 KE Masinga (Old Fort) Road not later than 11:00 on Friday, 22nd January 2010. Should the author fail to comply substantially with the criteria above, the representation and/or objection maybe regarded by the eThekweni Municipality as invalid.
