

# Roads career expo

MORE than 60 pupils attended a recent careers expo organised by the Special Projects Unit and the eThekweni Transport Authority (ETA).

The youngsters toured the Traffic Control and the Road Engineering Department, where they learnt about design, planning and the materials used in building roads and bridges.

Urban Traffic Control Head Adrian Aucamp explained the importance of properly structuring roads and how air pollution could be reduced through easing traffic flow.

He said that the main cause of road damage was rain and this

could be minimised through planning, which required statisticians and planners.

Head of Skills Development and Engineering, Eric Latleiff, said testing had to be done before the right materials could be chosen to build or repair roads and structures. There were career opportunities in engineering and geology, but pupils needed good marks in maths and science for this, said Latleiff.

ETA Project Manager Japhet Mkhabela urged pupils to make the most of the expo. "Before you realise it, you will find high school is over and you haven't chosen a career," he said.
