



**RE-ADVERTISEMENT: REQUEST FOR QUOTATION – IT 07/2016**

**SUPPLY OF INTERNET CONNECTIVITY FOR THE DURBAN ICC (Wi-Fi)**

**1. Background**

The Durban ICC is one of the most advanced conferencing facilities in the world, having been voted Africa's Leading Conference Centre by the World Travel Awards for 15 years. The Centre is graded 5-star by the South African Tourism Grading Council.

The business currently uses a combination of dedicated fibre optic bandwidth connectivity as well as ADSL for the provision of internet services to both the Durban ICC internal network and client Wi-Fi network.

**2. Purpose**

The Durban ICC requires an internet service provider (registered with ICASA) for the provision of internet services, for a period of 12 months.

**3. Minimum Requirements**

Please note: the Fibre optic backbone currently in place is the Metro connect fibre between the Durban ICC and Terraco (This connection terminates on a Cisco ME switch in the Durban ICC server room).
