CALL FOR PROPOSALS: KWADABEKA AGRI-TOURISM SITE PLAN

The Economic Development and Investment Promotion Unit of the eThekweni Municipality is calling for proposals from suitably qualified and experienced individuals, companies or consortia to produce a plan for the redevelopment of the decommissioned KwaDabeka Waste Water Works as a mixed use facility for agriculture, eco-tourism and social services. The plan should provide the basis for a detailed feasibility assessment and further business and architectural planning.

The plan will include:

- A site layout based on permaculture principles to accommodate a combination of conservation, agriculture, sport, recreation, eco-tourism and social services.
- A plan for rainwater harvesting and an engineering assessment of existing storage infrastructure.
- Demarcation of conservation areas and recommendations for wetland rehabilitation
- An architectural design concept for the renovation and use of existing buildings and infrastructure.
- A concept model for the agricultural development on the site.

The service provider should:

- Have suitable professional qualifications and experience with relevant projects.
- Have a good understanding of environmental conservation and large scale permaculture design.
- Be experienced in working with local community groups in South Africa
- Be able to supply a minimum of three traceable references related to the scope of work required.
