REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FROM SUITABLE SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE UPDATING, MAINTENANCE AND HOSTING OF AN INTERACTIVE MAP AND MOBILE – ENABLED WEBSITE FOR THE LIBERATION HERITAGE ROUTE IN ETHEKWINI MUNICIPALITY FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS
SCOPE

1) Review and update virtual interactive map and responsive website

Based on 30 sites identified so far, but including the extension of the map to include all future LHR sites across the whole of Durban.

- eThekwini Municipality requires the service providers to assess and review the current plan of how the website is working to make suggestions of improvements where necessary in order to enhance capacity for extension and constant updating or editing of information by Local History Museum staff.
- Develop methods to improve methods of input from staff members OR accredited outsiders who wish to comment. Maintenance and updating of Facebook, YouTube and Twitter accounts, including community engagement and promotion through these networks.

2) Hosting and maintenance of virtual interactive map and responsive website

Following the review of the website's current format of the Durban Inner-city Liberation Heritage Route website and any revisions agreed upon, eThekwini Municipality requires the service provider to edit the website (if necessary) and host the content for a period of twelve months.

- The original proposal for this project included provision for QR-code capacity to link the limited content on the physical plaques with addition information via the website. A decision has since been made to link the route markers to the project website by means of an SMS (short message service) or 'text message' system as this is a universal technology. The appointed service provider is required to establish a designated number and series of unique codes in order to supply users a hyperlink as a reply. When users click the hyperlink, users are taken to the project website and a more detailed information relating to that specific site.
- Posting of 4 blog entries per month on the site, containing information that is relevant to the LHR, with a total of at least 48 blog posts over the 12-month duration of the contract.
